Enjoy the Farm:


To make your Christmas complete, our friendly animals are waiting to meet you in the farmyard and pets area. For those bringing packed lunches, there will be a Christmas film to enjoy in the Pennywell Theatre.

You need to arrive fifteen minutes before your performance time, unless you have booked to have lunch in the Pennywell Theatre. The first 45 minutes will be the Nativity Play followed by visits to Father Christmas and refreshments. As the play is in the barn, please make sure that children have warm clothes, hats and coats. Wellington boots are not required

Booking your Nativity Play:

Either phone or email Pennywell with your first and second choice of performance to check availability and make a provisional booking. To confirm your booking, complete the booking and send with a **£50 deposit**, payable to Pennywell Education, within 7 days of your provisional booking.

This pre booked performance is **£9.95** per person with one FREE adult place to every ten paying children. This includes admission, the Nativity Play and a present from Father Christmas, plus a Christmas biscuit and squash for each child and mince pies, mulled wine, tea or coffee for the adults.
